CHAMPIONS GATE, FL March 20, 2020 – Tyler Patrick is releasing a short collection of flash fiction stories based on the theme of dark humor. This collection, named *Oddities of Haven Hollow*, is being published on Smashwords.com as a free ebook.

The collection includes three stories tied together with the theme of dark, irreverent humor. Loosely inspired by the Isabella Stewart Gardner art heist of 1990, “The Heist” is the story of Bobby and Joey, two art thieves on their last job. Trying to get priceless works of art that will set them up for the rest of their lives, Bobby and Joey must navigate the St Patrick’s Day drunks, security guard, local police, and even each other to complete this goal.

“What Plays at Night” is the most serious of these stories. It tells the tale of a lone survivor fleeing for their life from an unknown entity. They are trapped in the beast’s hunting grounds and escape is not likely. A heart-pounding and tense experience of a read for those who dare.

“Salad, Please “ is the final story in this collection. A twisted comedy, “Salad, Please” shows what happens when two werewolves, Gary and Theo, walk into the Haven Hollow Diner. Gary is gruff and carnivorous while his son Theo is a shy and considerate vegan. These two square off in a battle of wits and eye rolling as the few patrons left in the diner watch on.

These stories are wildly different in their genres, but keep the twisted humor of author, Tyler Patrick. They all revolve around some type of oddity. A couple of art thieves on St Patrick’s Day, a beast that hunts humans, and a vegan werewolf are all things we don’t typically run into in our everyday lives.
